

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how personal information is collected, used and protected when you visit joelcorry.com (the "Website").

The Website is operated independently by JOEL CORRY LTD ("we", "us" or "our").

1. Information we collect

When you visit the Website, our hosting infrastructure may record standard technical information in server logs, including your IP address (which may indicate an approximate location), browser type, device type, pages requested, timestamps, and security logs. We also store a first-party cookie that records that you have seen the cookie notice.

If you join the mailing list, we collect:

- your first name and email address
- your telephone number, if you choose to provide it
- whether you have opted in to email marketing
- whether you have opted in to SMS or WhatsApp messages

We do not require an account to browse the Website, and we do not sell your personal information.

2. How we use your information

We use personal information to:

- operate, maintain and secure the Website
- record that you have seen the cookie notice
- store your newsletter details and marketing preferences in our database
- so the team can contact you about new music, tour dates and related updates, where you have opted in
- so the team can send SMS or WhatsApp messages later, only if you have opted in and provided a phone number
- update or delete your record if you email the team to unsubscribe
- protect the Website against spam, fraud and abuse
- comply with legal obligations

3. Legal bases

Where UK data protection law applies, we rely on:

- Consent - storing your choice to receive email marketing and SMS or WhatsApp. You can withdraw that consent by sending an email to the team or by writing to us.
- Legitimate interests - operating and securing the Website (including essential music, video and tour players), preventing abuse of the sign-up form, and keeping basic technical logs.
- Legal obligation - where we must keep or disclose information to comply with the law.

4. Cookies

The Website uses a first-party cookie banner to explain essential cookies. Necessary cookies (including the cookie that records that you have seen the notice) keep the site working. Spotify, YouTube and Bandsintown

players are required for music, videos and tour dates, so they load as essential features and those providers may set their own cookies.

We do not use Google Analytics, Meta Pixel, advertising cookies, or a third-party cookie-consent platform. Cookie Settings in the footer reopens this notice.

5. Marketing

The Website stores newsletter sign-ups in our own database. It does not send marketing emails or SMS from the site itself. We only store your details if you submit the form, and we only store an email or SMS opt-in if you tick that box. If you want to unsubscribe or have your details deleted, send an email to the team. SMS or WhatsApp opt-in also requires a phone number and confirmation that you are 13 or over. Marketing is not required to browse the Website.

6. Who we share information with

- our hosting, database and infrastructure providers, acting on our instructions
- Spotify, YouTube and Bandsintown, which power essential music, video and tour features on the Website
- professional advisers or authorities if the law requires it

We do not share your mailing list with any record label.

7. International transfers

Some of the providers above may process information outside the UK. Where that happens, we take steps required by UK law, such as using providers that offer an appropriate safeguard or relying on a UK adequacy decision where one applies.

8. How long we keep information

Newsletter details are stored in our database until you ask us to remove them. If you email the team to unsubscribe, we will stop using your details for marketing and may keep a minimal record so we do not contact you again by mistake. Cookie-notice records and server logs are kept only as long as needed. We may keep information longer if required by law.

9. Your rights

If you are in the UK or the EEA, you may have the right to access, correct, delete or restrict your personal information, to object to certain processing, and to data portability. Where we rely on consent, you can withdraw it at any time by sending an email to the team or by writing to us.

To exercise your rights, write to us at the address in section 12. You can also complain to the ICO at ico.org.uk.

10. Security

We use reasonable technical and organisational measures to protect personal information. No internet transmission can be guaranteed completely secure.

11. Children

The Website is aimed at a general audience. The SMS/WhatsApp option is not for anyone under 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children. If you believe we have, write to us and we will delete it.
